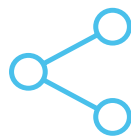

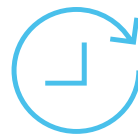

After the District Attorney's Office sets up prosecutors as authenticated users in their account, your agency can easily select prosecutors from a list within the Share Manager page and begin sharing.



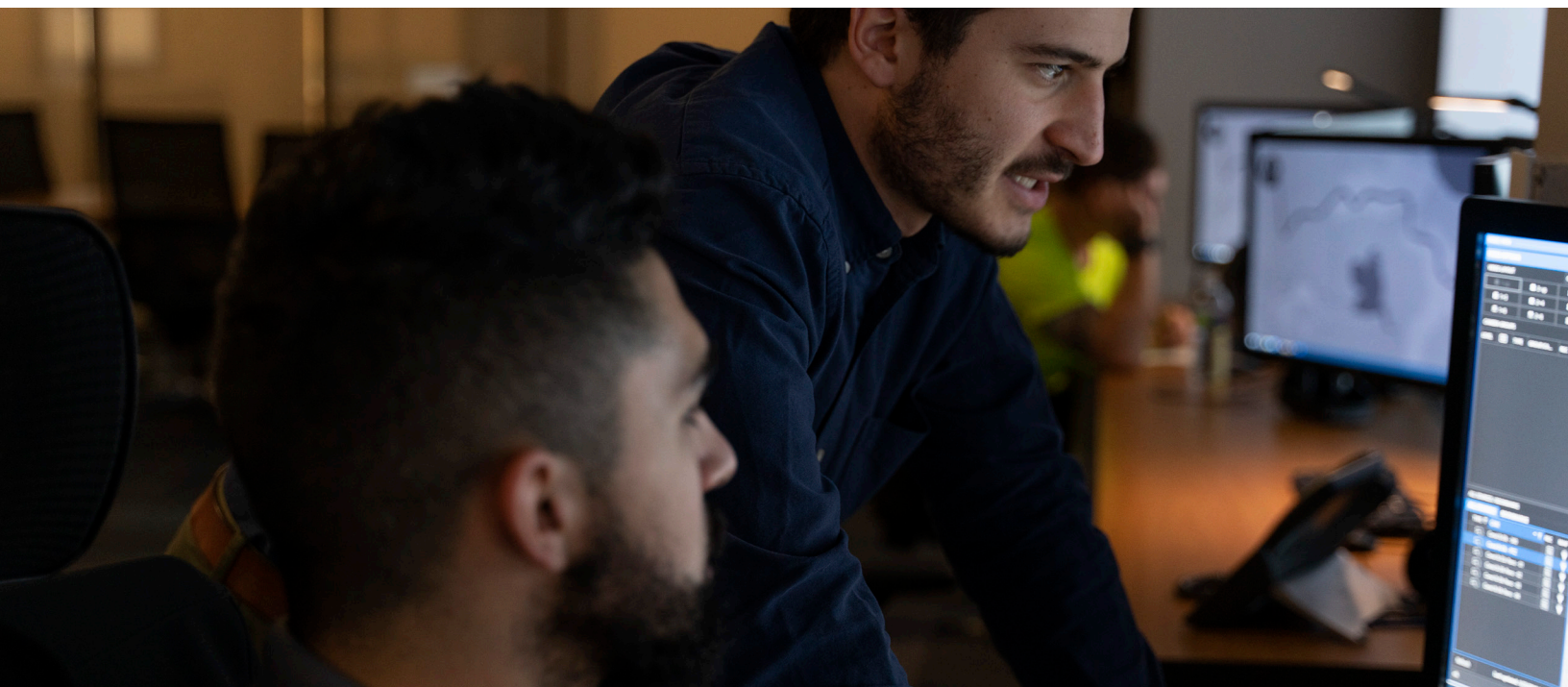
SET A TIME LIMIT TO VIEW THE CASE

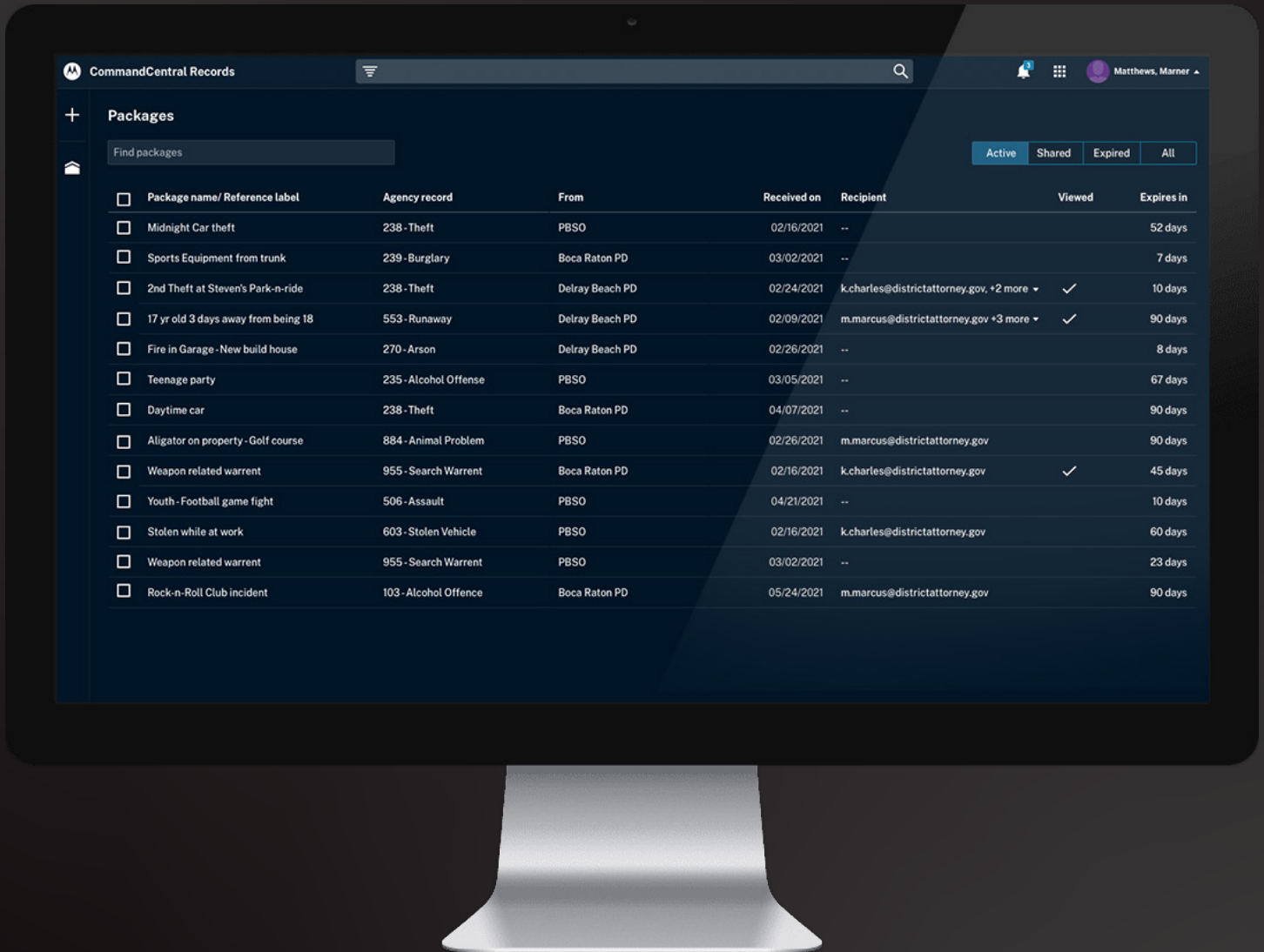
Set a time limit for judicial partners to access the case, so you always know who can view your cases at all times.

SEARCH AND FILTER SHARED CASES

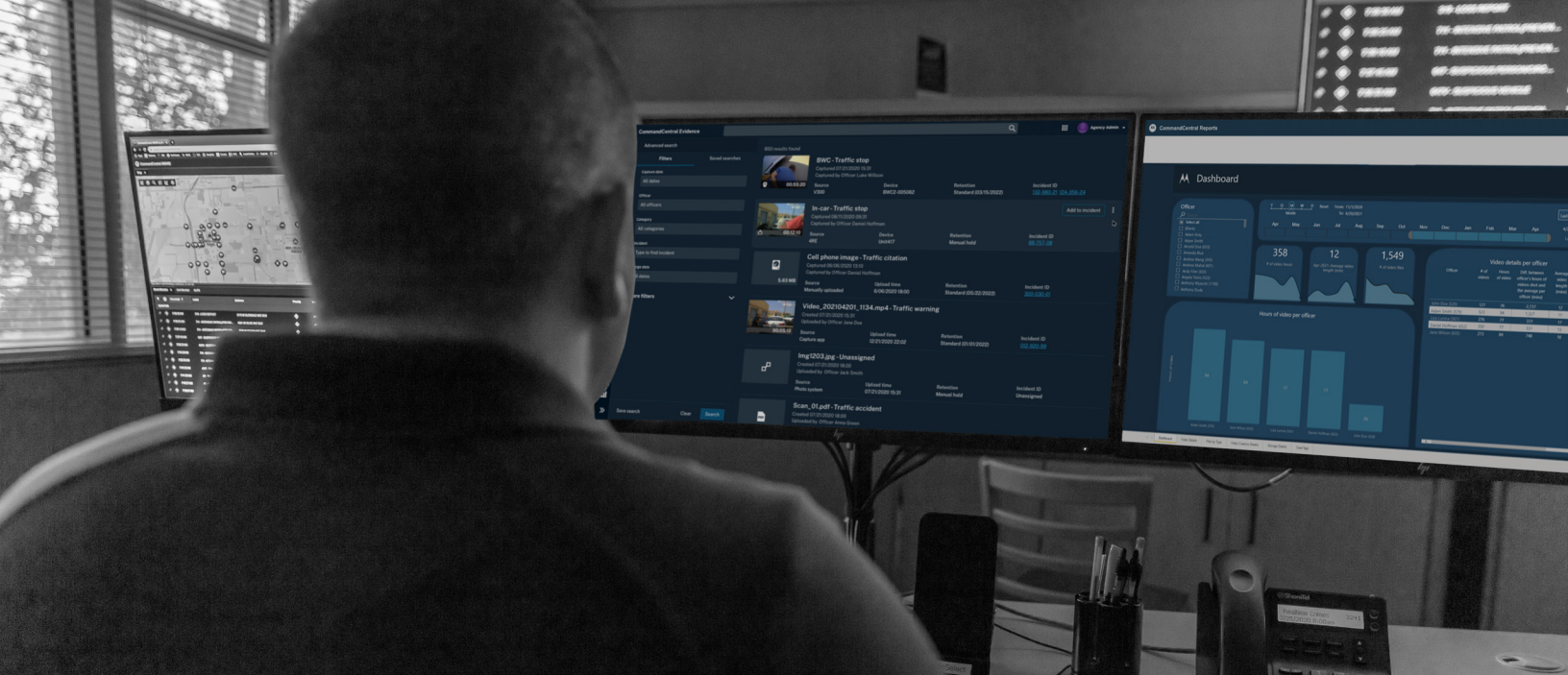
Search shared cases and media to quickly find the information you need. You can also filter by active, shared, or expired packages.
